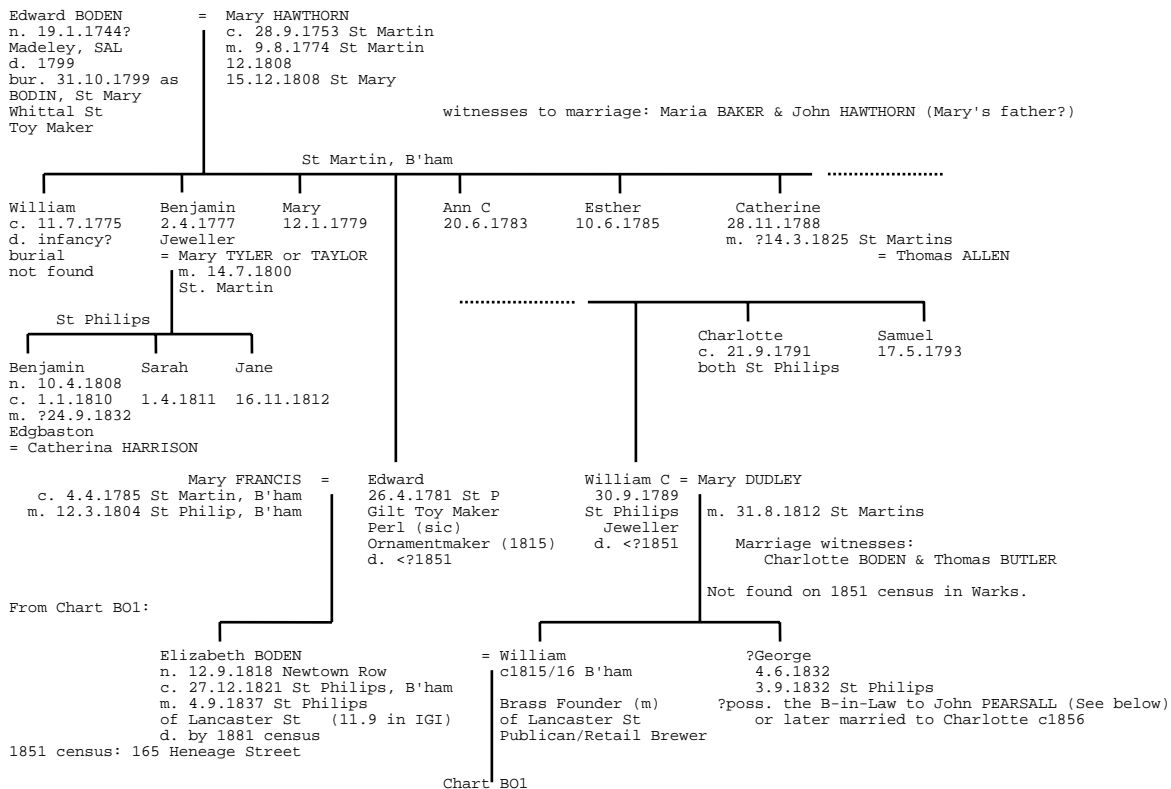

BODEN Documents (or copies)

- Letters of Administration to Mary BODEN over the estate of Edward BODEN 2.5.1800 (2 documents). She died before completion. Three documents dated 17/8/1815 - Letters of Administration granted to Benjamin BODEN s/o Edward & Mary. One document witnessed by Edward BODEN & John DOE.

"At Lichfield 2nd May 1800 before the Reverend Theophilus Buckeridge, AM Surrogate.

Appeared personally Mary BODEN and suggested that Edward BODEN late of the town of Birmingham in the County of Warwick and Diocese of Lichfield and Coventry Toy Maker deceased died upwards of fourteen days since intestate and that she is the Widow relict of the said deceased wherefor she prayed Letters of Administration of his goods and personal estate to be granted to her which the Surrogate aforesaid upon her making the usual oath and giving good security decreed to be granted to her as prayed

The said Mary BODEN was then duly sworn also that the deceased's personal estate is not of the value of 300 pounds before me T. Buckeridge Surrogate."

18th August 1815:

"Whereas we have decreed letters of administration of the goods and personal estate of Edward BODEN late of Birmingham in the County of Warwick and diocese of Coventry, toymaker, deceased, who died intestate leaving Mary BODEN his widow (as is alleged) to be granted to Benjamin BODEN the natural and lawful son of the deceased. we therefore commit and grant to you.....full power to administer the oath underwritten to the said Benjamin BODEN. N.B. Relict who took out letters of administration of his goods and personal estate but died before she had fully administered the same."

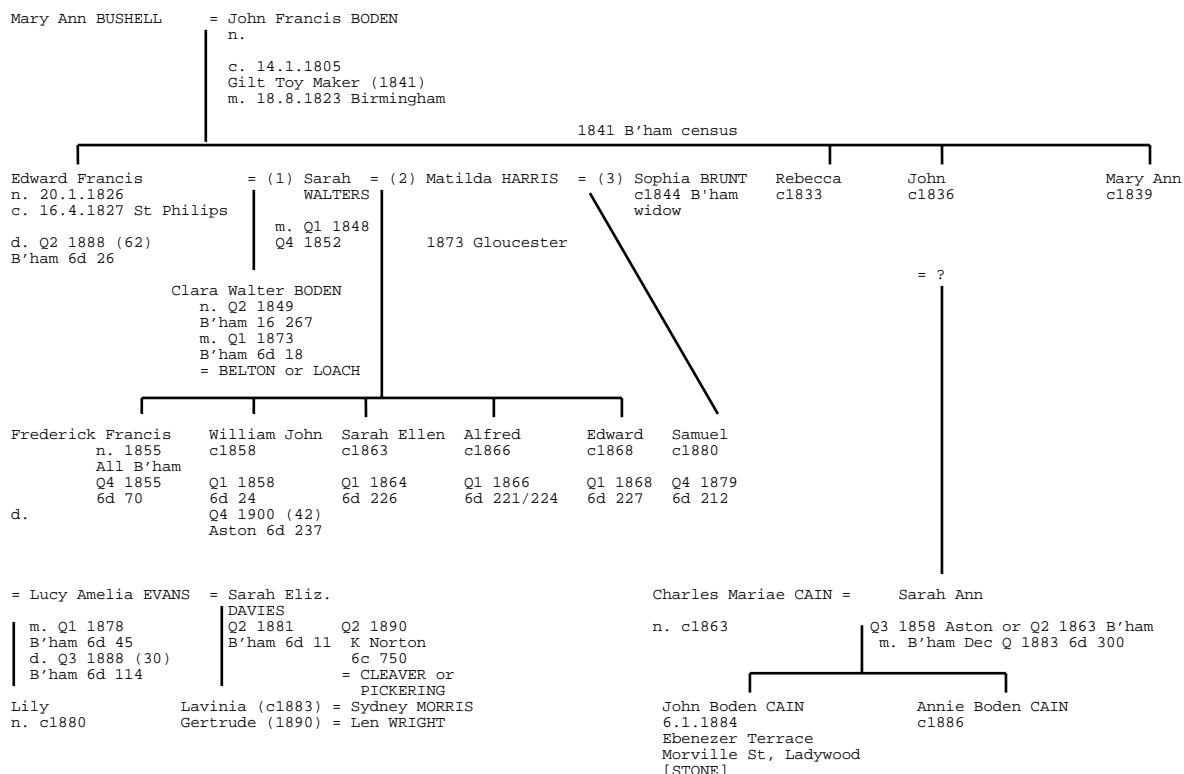

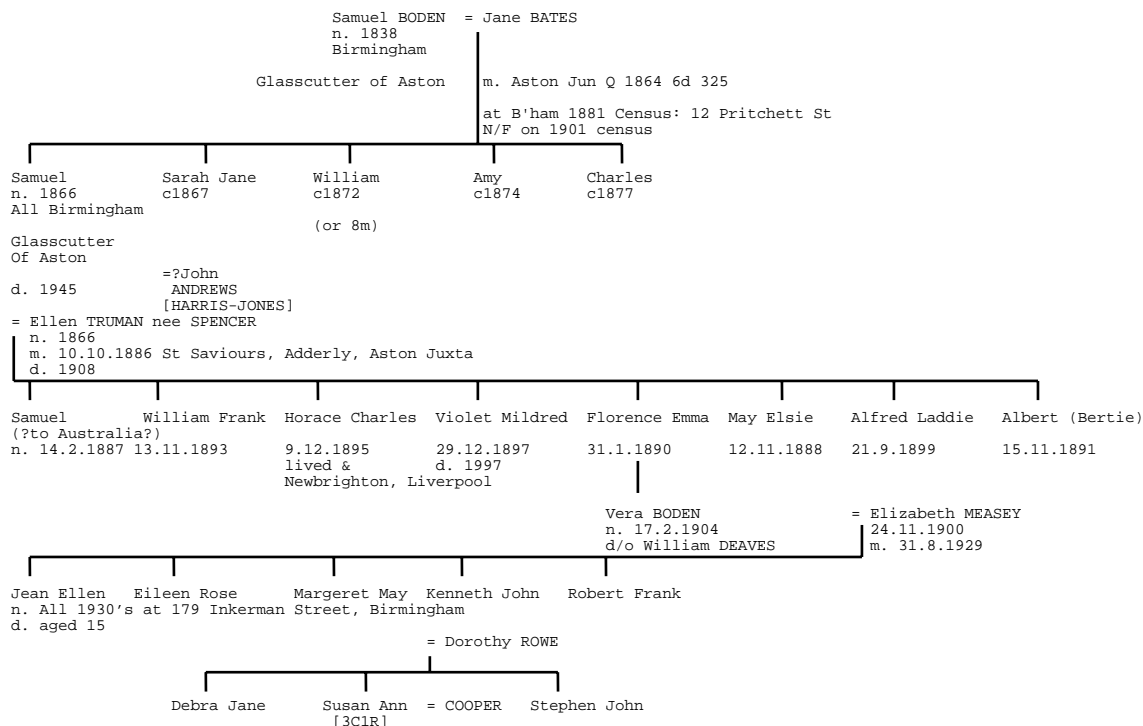
