## BUSH Notes

A small coal vein in Kingswood was known as Bush's described in 1726 "which lieth at the bottom of the hills by Cadberry Heath leading to the windmill."

IGI refs. in Hanham & Oldland back to 1590's but non specific to this family

Aaron a follower of independent lay preacher John CENNICK mentioned 13.12.1740 as being single  
Agnes = Walter HANLE 13.7.1598 H&O  
Agneta c. 19.2.1612 Marshfield  
Ann +27.12.1681 H&O  
Betty One of many declaring themselves without sin and prayed only for others (August 1740)  
Betty CENNICK wrote 18.6.1741: "About this time, Betty BUSH, the chief perfectionist in Kingswood sent me a blasphemous letter which I read before my mother, and several, and laid it on a table to expose it, but before us all...". The narrative is lost due to page missing in diary.

Grace In Bristol Wills, the testament of Bartholomew BUSH, a glover from St James Parish, Bristol in 1603, mentions his young daughter Grace

Gregory = 16.11.1669 Bristol, vintner of St Nicholas, and Ann WRAXALL of Bitton. William ROGERS of Castle, Cordwainer at Temple, bondsman.

James Yeoman in the Parish of St Philip & Jacob; at least 4 children: Elizabeth (c1731), Giles (c1735), Judith (c1738) & James (c1739). Will in 1750.

Peter a follower of independent lay preacher John CENNICK mentioned 13.12.1740 as being single, hearer of the Methodists, but in no Society

Marriage in Kelston for William BUSH and Joane WILCOX 31.5.1551

Probates & Admons 1564-1611:

P.98 July 19th Elinor WILCOCKES Wid. Kelston ab def Ad to Joan BUSHE her daughter. (unclear about the date on this)

1599 John WILCOCKE of Kelston mentioned in the section on debts owed in the will of Giles BUSH of Charlcombe. Giles has a wife Joane and a son William.

1606 a William BUSH was churchwarden at Kelston.

1609 Joane BUSHE dau of William BUSHE ch at Kelston.

1623 will of Thomas BUSHE clothier of Kelston, son of William BUSHE (living), mentions wife Frances dau of William BRITTON (living), sisters Ann GUNNING (wife of William GUNNING), Mary ORGAN (wife of James) and Joane BUSHE.
