

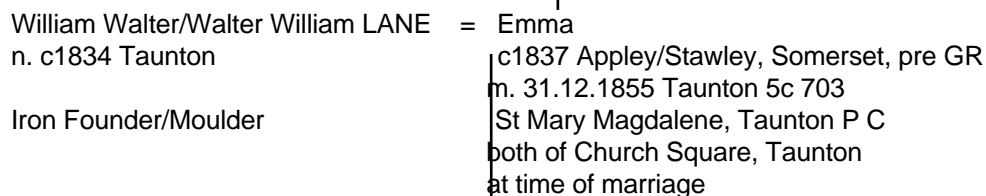
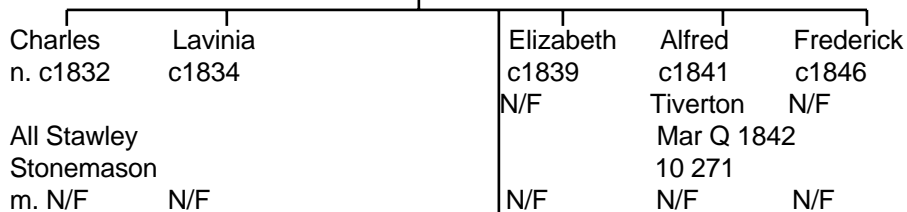
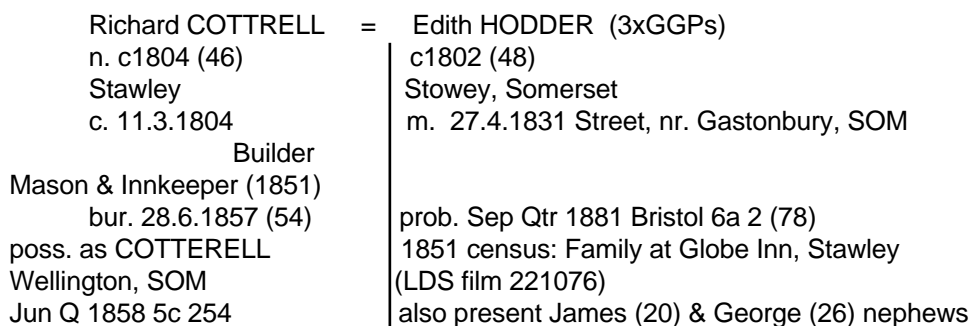
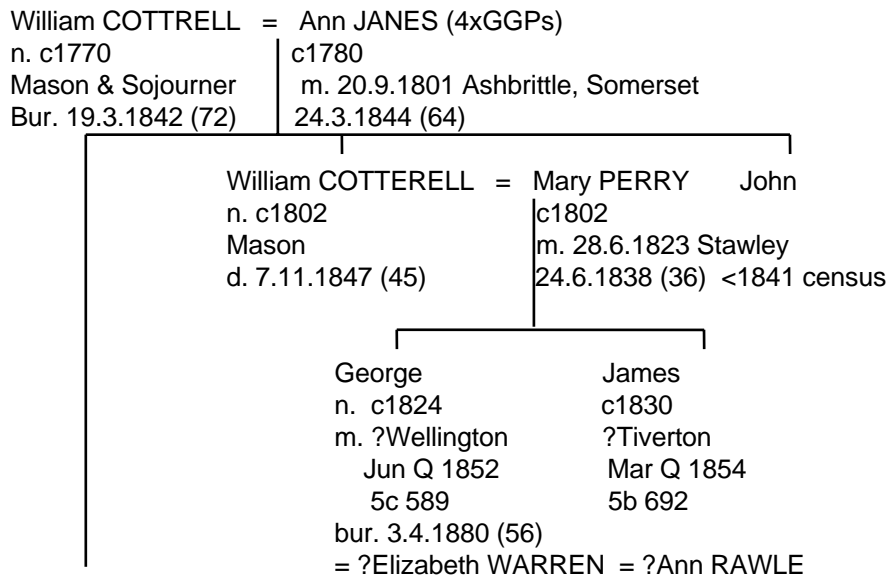
## COTTRELL FAMILY

### COTTRELL/COTTERELL Family (Stawley, Taunton, and the Devonshire/Somerset Borders: Late C18th - Mid C19th)

1841 census: LDS film 474601

William's family was next door to another William COTTRELL (the elder)

### Notes

Many COTTRELL's in Devon/Somerset border villages west of Taunton, which include in the 1881 census for Somerset Stawley, Ashbrittle & Holcombe Rogus. COTTRELLs today are farmers in the area.

In 1851 Richard COTTRELL sold the Globe Inn to a man named HAWKINS. The area was 1 rod, 18 poles, with an orchard of 2 rods, 30 poles, totalling 1 sq. acre, 8 poles valued at 4 shillings and 8 pence.

In 1870 a DOBLE & a COTTRELL, masons, restored the church at Ashbrittle.

Dennis (78), labourer from Ashbrittle & Ann (69) from North Curry, East of Taunton.

[Note: at Ashbrittle in 1881 were the families of James & Henry COTTRELL. Also a William of Ashbrittle at Bedminster:

At Ashbrittle: James (38) n. c1842 Ashbrittle, Builder & Farm Lab.

[Ashbrittle monument: Wife Anne d. 26.3.1863 (20); James d. 14.7.1887 (44)]

At Ashbrittle: Henry (54) n. c1826 Ashbrittle, Road Contractor]

Children of unknown parents buried at Ashbrittle:

Fanny (d. 16.1.1868 – 2y 3mo) & Fred (d. 26.6.?1868 – 7 mo) on same monument

At Taunton, St James

Samuel H D (Leather Dresser) & Augusta (42) of Taunton, with children Augusta E (14) of Taunton & Henry S (16) Gas Fitter of Bedminster

At Bridgwater  
Family of William of Taunton (47) Green Grocer

At Stawley (birthplace of Emma)  
Elizabeth (50) widowed Seamstress of Holcombe Rogus, Devon & son William W (24) Slate Merchant  
of Stawley  
(could be the widow of one of Emma's brothers?)  
The slate was quarried at Tracebridge, a small hamlet between Ashbrittle & Appley.

3 COTTRELL graves present at Ashbrittle;

"In loving memory of **Anne COTTRELL** who died March 26th 1863 aged 20 years,  
Also **James**, husband of the above died July 14th 1887 aged 44"  
[James n. c1843 - parents unknown; marriage unknown ~1863. He was a Builder & Farm  
Labourer in 1881 Ashbrittle]

"In memory of **Fanny COTTRELL** died January 16th 1868 aged 2 years 3 months  
**Fred COTTRELL** died June 26th aged 7 months" [year not given]  
[parents not known]

"In memory of **Henry COTTRELL** who died June 14th 1868 aged 23 years"  
[n. c1845 - parents unknown]

3 COTTRELL graves present at Stawley church;

"Mary COTTRELL d. 20.6.1838 (36) & William d. 29.10.1847 (45). George d. (date unreadable)" would  
appear to be part of family tree, above

"In Loving Memory of William George Warren COTTRELL who died November 28<sup>th</sup> 1889 - Aged 33  
years" [probably s/o George COTTRELL & Elizabeth WARREN]

" In Loving Memory of Elizabeth beloved wife of George COTTRELL who died April ?9<sup>th</sup> ?1890, aged  
60 years"
