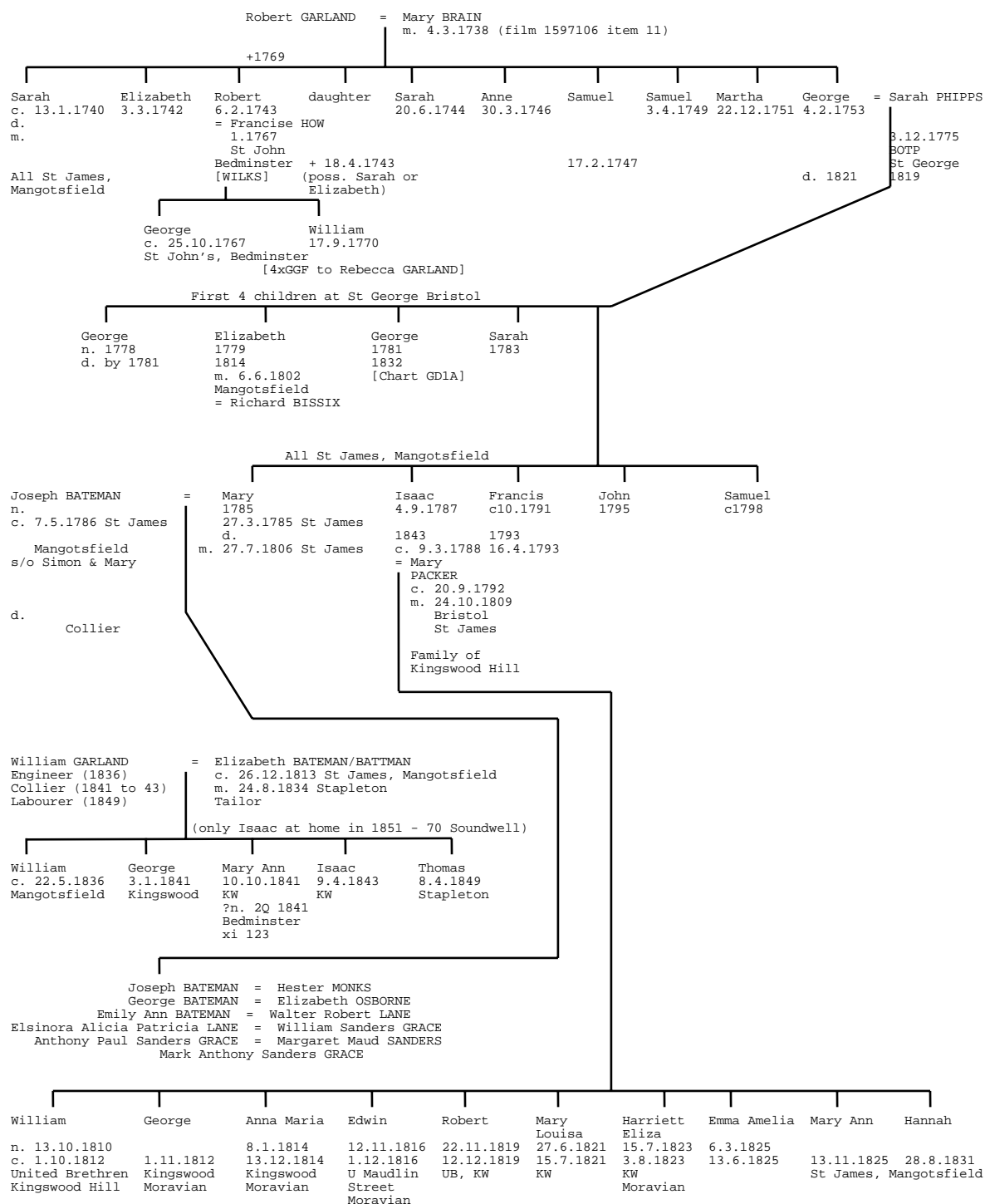
Introductory Note

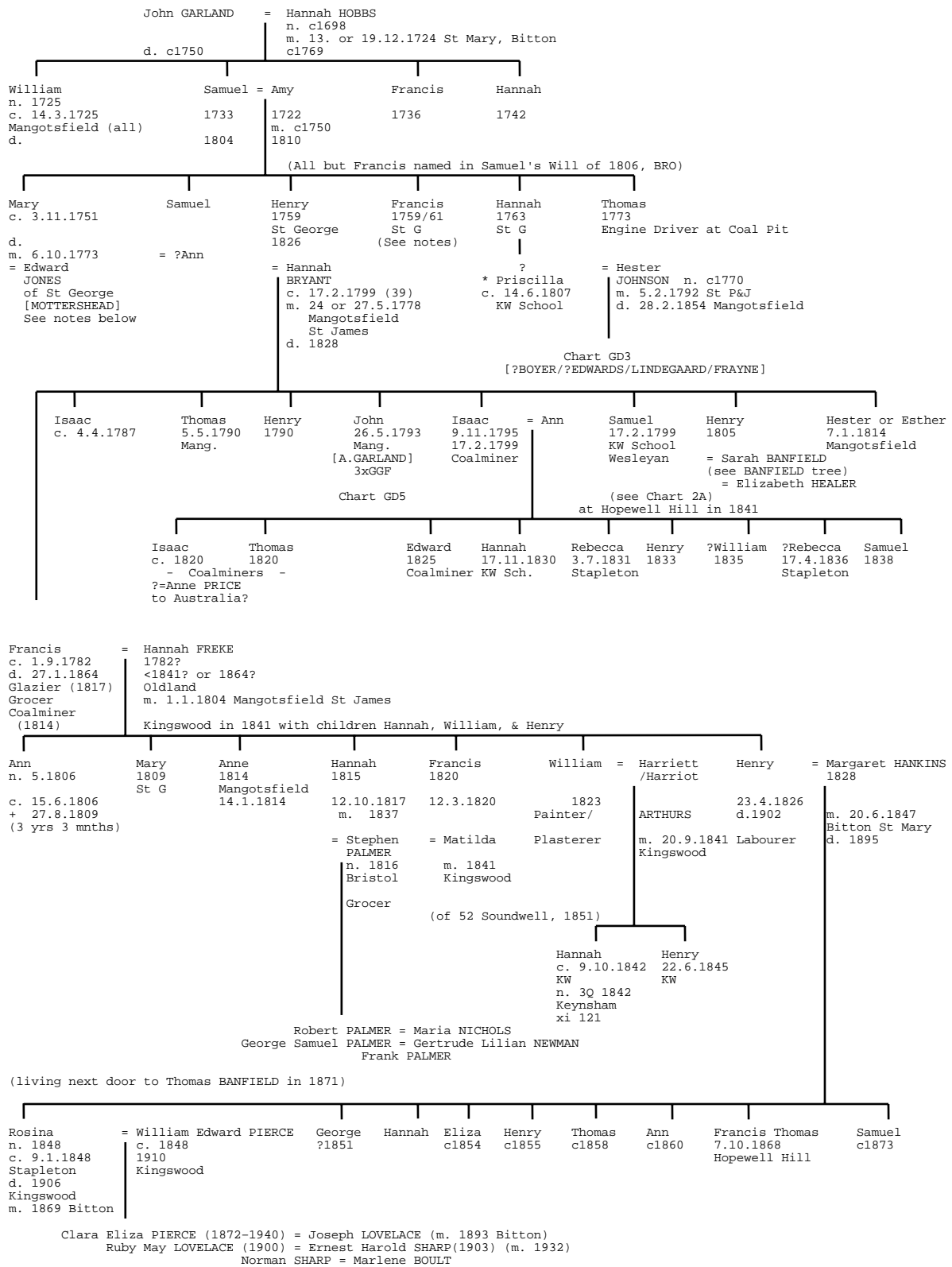

Will of Samuel GARLAND 1/5/1802 - Proved 3/11/1806
In the name of God amen.

I Samuel GARLAND now living in the Parish of Mangotsfield in the County of Gloucester do make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament as follows: I give devise and bequeath unto my wife Amy GARLAND all that dwelling house that I now living in and orchard garden and one Inclosure Rented now by William BRAIN (crossed out: "and one other little leasehold cottages rented by Thomas GARLAND my son...") to take all Rents and Profits for the term of her natural life All the said Premises is (Ioiened) together in the Parish of Mangotsfield and County aforementioned after my wife decease I give and devise and bequeath the whole of my effects aforegiven to my wife to be equally divided between my children hereinafter named that is I give one fifth part unto my son Samuel GARLAND one other fifth part unto my son Henry GARLAND one other fifth part unto my son Thomas GARLAND and other fifth part unto my daughter Mary JONES wife of Edward JONES one other fifth part unto my daughter Hannah GARLAND. And my will is that if Any of my sons or daughters shall die before theirs fifth part becomes due that their issues shall have theirs fifth part divided between all of them and if any of my sons or daughters should want to sell or dispose of his or her part that they shall be at liberty immediately to sell for the most money they can have for the same. I give and bequeath to my wife Amy GARLAND all my household goods and all moneys to be Injoyed and used by her for the Term of her Natural Life and after my wife decease I give and bequeath to my daughter Hannah GARLAND my Dwelling House that I now living in excepted from the fore givings for so long a time as her doth continue a singerley young woman, But if her doth marry or cohabit with any man then it shall become void (true) her immediately and Injoyed by her no longer time.

Francis GARLAND (c1761-)

Extract from "From Bristol Exported"

"Francis GARLAND was one of six men (including John LEARY, Joseph MORLEY and Henry ROACH) who committed a highway robbery stealing twelve yards of muslin and other goods valued at £5.13s., for which they were sentenced to death at Winchester, Hants, on 3 March 1783. GARLAND, reprieved to seven years transportation on 21 April, was sent to a Thames hulk and thence, with MORLEY and ROACH, to the Mercury transport on 26 March 1784. GARLAND escaped after a mutiny on board and was recaptured at Plymouth Dock [Devonport] with William ROBINSON (q.v.) and William CASEY and lodged in an Exeter goal (probably the Bridewell, his name not on the Devon Gaol Calendar). Tried by the Special Commission on -- May, GARLAND was sentenced to death again and was not reprieved until 9 August. He was sent to the *Dunkirk* hulk, aged 23, at the end of the month. His behaviour was "troublesome at times" until embarked on *Charlotte* on 11 March 1787.

GARLAND's first and seemingly only record after landing at Port Jackson in 1788 was his marriage on 24 December 1791 to Sarah BARTLAM (*Mary Ann* 1791). No record of his death has been found. In 1806 Sarah "BARTLUM" was a housekeeper to John BAYLEY, in 1814 as Sarah BARTLETT she was living with Abraham KEMP (*Barwell* 1798) and in 1828 a servant to George HALL at Pitt Town. GARLAND was either dead before 1806 or left the colony without his wife. She died as BARTLAM on 2 January 1848."

The above account would explain his absence from Samuel's will.

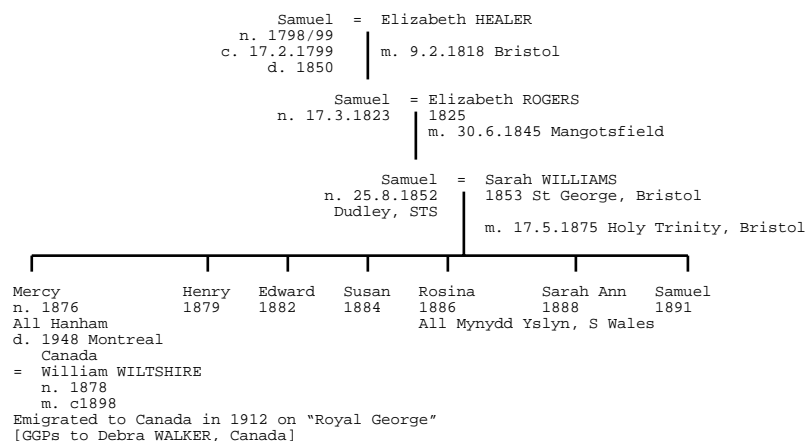

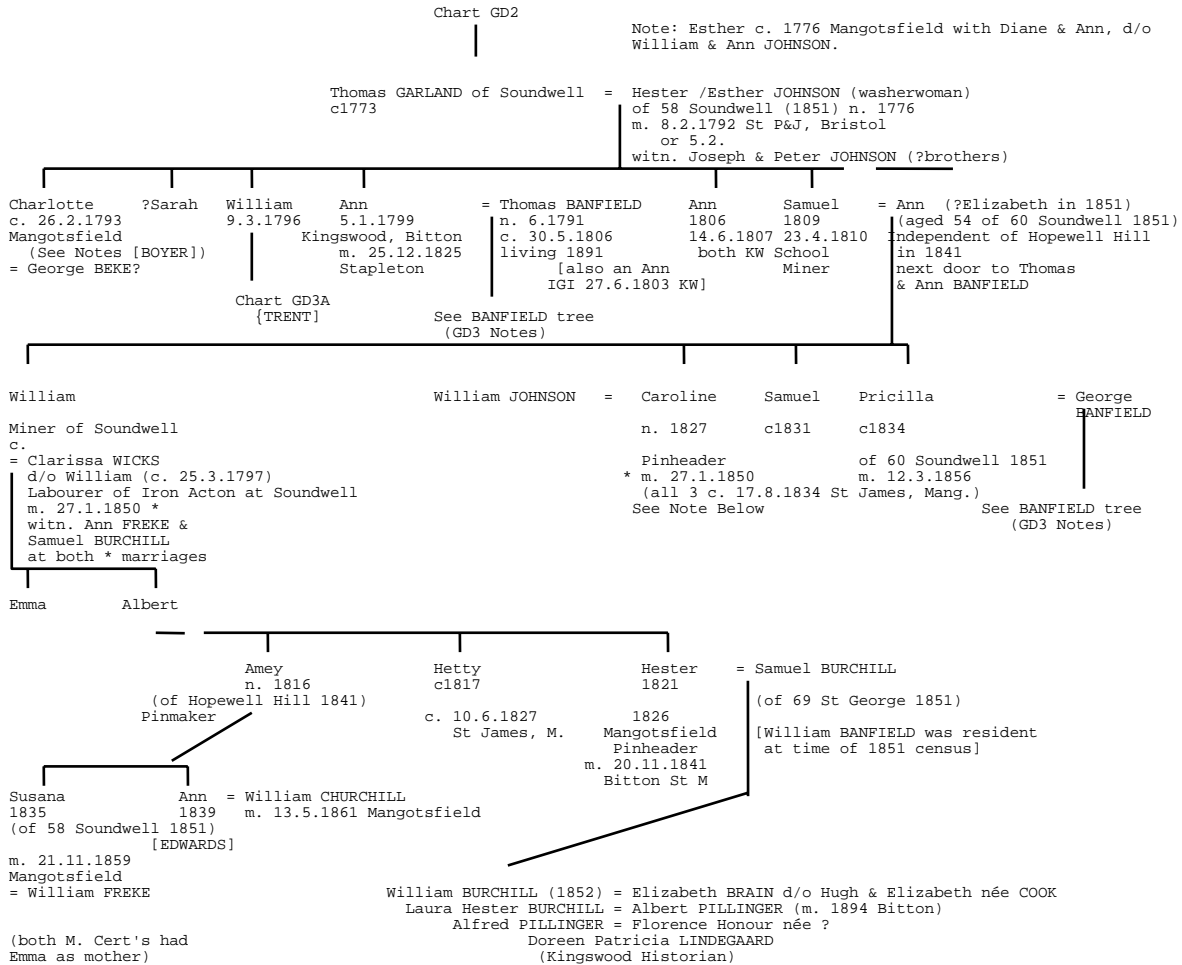

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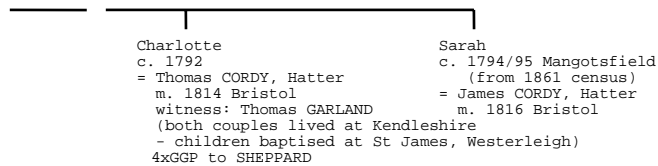

This is not the same Caroline GARLAND (born about the same time) who married William JOHNSON on Chart GD3 may be incorrect as parents were given as Samuel & Elizabeth GARLAND not Samuel & Ann GARLAND. This also may be an error.

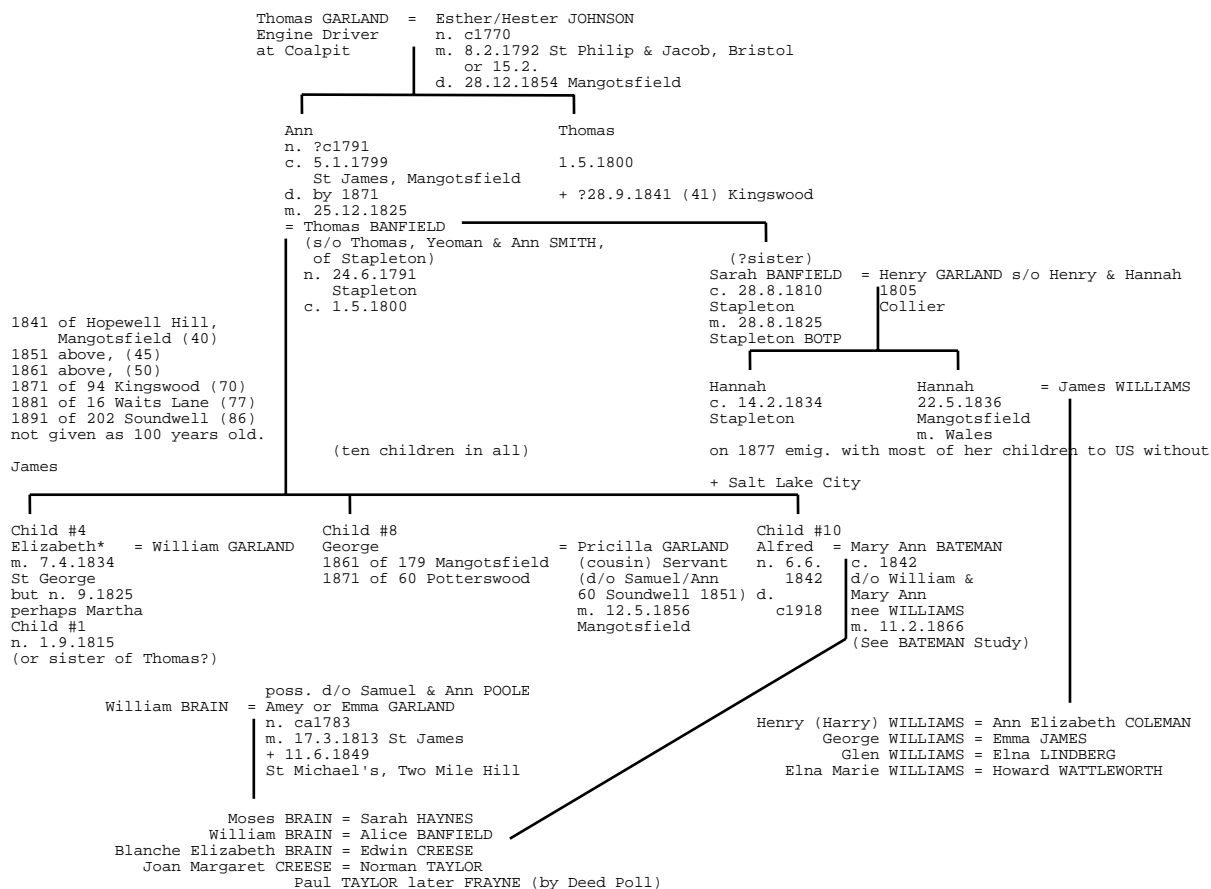

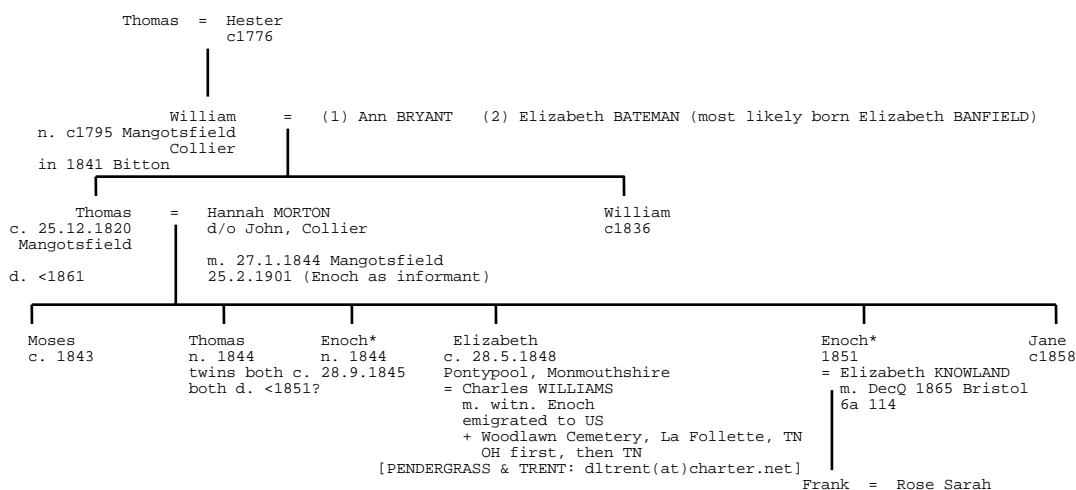

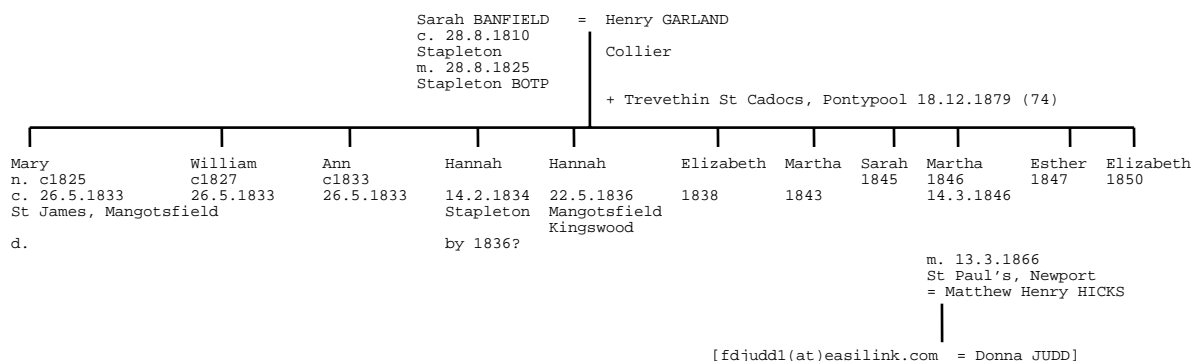

Henry's ancestry uncertain



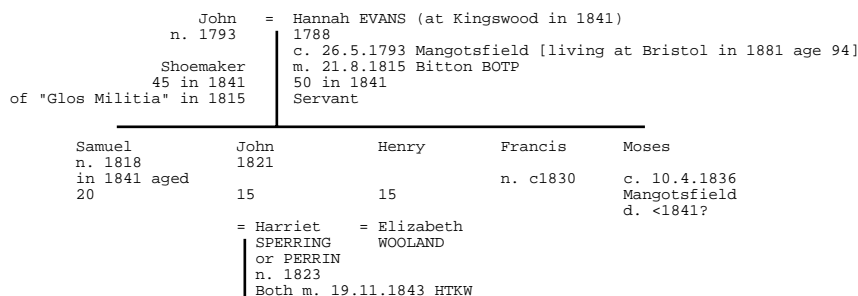

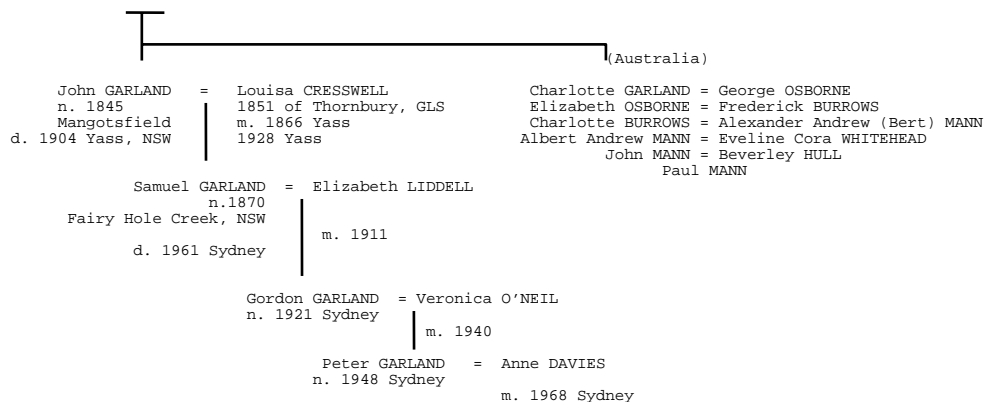
Chart GD5: Descendants of John GARLAND and Hannah EVANS of Kingswood then Australia [Anne GARLAND / MANN]

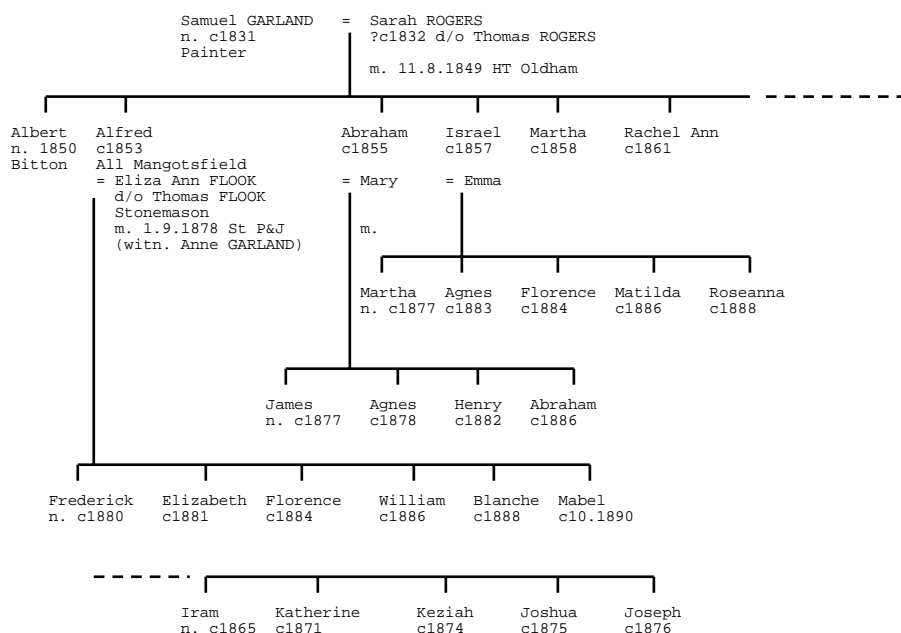

George GARLAND (1777) d. 12.2.1859 Oldland, aged 82, Seaman RN Pensioner of unknown medical cause.

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Stephen GARLAND

s/o George & Ann, aged 12 c. 15.6.1806 Mangotsfield. 1851 census confirms his birth around 1793. [4xGGF to Karen KRICH]. 1851 Dudley census with birthplace as Kingswood (Shoemaker). One of his sons went to the US in the late 1860's and was a coalminer (Karen's direct line). In same census, also Robert GARLAND (15) of Kingswood, also Samuel GARLAND (24) of Bristol. Samuel probably is probably the son of Stephen as there is a 14 year old Samuel living in Stephen's household in 1841 Dudley. Stephen was married in 1819 in Tipton, but appears to go back and forth to the Bristol area based on the birth of Samuel above and a daughter listed as born in Somerset, Nailsea about 1833 although she was baptized in Dudley.

History of the GARLAND family pertaining to the legacy in Chancery, England. Left by Sir Wm. Watkins WYNN (copied from old letters by W.D. GARLAND 19.1.1910, and recopied from the original by James N. GARLAND 17.4.1939):

"I W.D. GARLAND do herewith relate the history of the GARLAND family as it came to me.

The folling (sic) is an account of our Grand Parents and their childrens (sic) names. My Great Great Grandfather's name. George GARLAND. His occupation, Colliery Carpenter. Great Great Grandmother's name Ann GARLAND. Their family of six children, four sons and two daughters were born and reared in Kingswood, Mangots field Parish. County of Gloucester, three miles from Bristol, England. No. 1 George, 2 Mary, 3 Joseph (+1.11.1813 (33), Backwell), 4 Hannah (= John SAMBOURNE), 5 Stephen, 6 Samuel.

George went to sea at the age of sixteen and was in the British Navy 35 years. Discharged with 1s 6d per day pension. Mary married James YORK. He was a shaft sinker. Joe GARLAND and him were working together. They had fired a shot and were coming up the shaft when the rope broke and killed both her husband and her brother. She was married again to John YENDLE, a Baker. He died and left her with six children.

Hannah married John SANSOME (aka SAMBOURNE), he was a gardener. She died leaving three children.

My Great Grandfather Stephen, enlisted in the British Army when eighteen years old. He was at the Battle of Waterloo two days. After he received his discharge, he went to Dudley and began to work at the slaughter pit in old Buffery Field. His brother Samuel came to Dudley after him and they both worked at the Buffery a many years. In 1827 at the time they were to receive the first money, they both worked at the Big Pear Tree Pits. Later called the Round Hovels, opposite the Mile Stone.

Stephen served two terms in the Worcestershire Militia. He received the last money in 1831. Just after the great riot in Bristol. He took us all to Nailsea. We lived there at the time the Cholera was raging in England in 1832. We lived there nearly two years then came back to Dudley. And Stephen met with his hurt soon after.

Stephen, he and Jane JONES were married in the old Parish Church Tipton - Staffordshire, England. Their children were all born in Dudley, except Jane. She was born at Little Nailsea, Somersetshire nine miles below Bristol. The foregoing is all that the original writer George GARLAND My Great Uncle knew about the GARLAND family. He states that he knew a man Mr. WHITTEN by name and met him he a welchman and through conversation he learned that he WHITTEN had been a servant for Sir Watkins WYNN. For a long time before he WYNN died.

He George my Great Uncle was promised some valuable information about Legacy by WHITTEN if he George My Great Uncle would call at his house. But he WHITTEN went home, took sick, and died. Therefore he did not get it.

He speaks about a certain law being passed for the government to find council for the poor people to plead their cases before the court of Chancery."

Joseph (+1.11.1813 (33), Backwell) and his brother-in-law James YORK (h/o Mary GARLAND) were killed in the same mining accident in Backwell in 1813. James & Mary m. 1809 Mangotsfield.

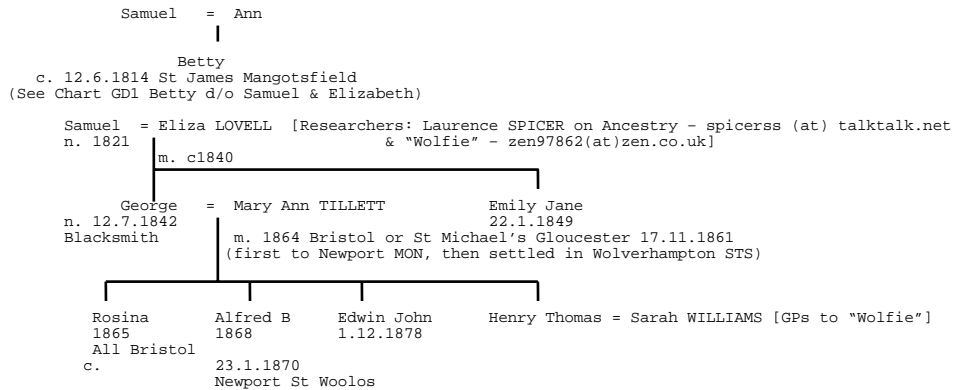

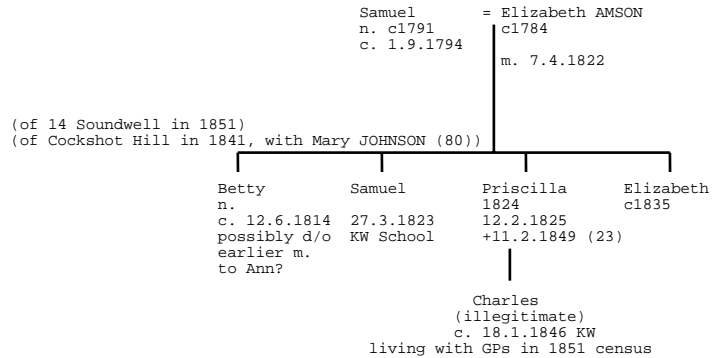

"Arrived in Auckland, NZ 9/09/1869 upon the Excelsior. Came to Cambridge to work under William and John Grice of Roto-o-rangi. He became a member of the Cambridge Cavalry Volunteers in 1872 and served until the troop disbanded in October 1882. When he and Sarah Kingdon married on 10 August 1873, they were the first couple to tie the knot in the original St Andrews Anglican church in Cambridge. Ben was a farmer, a veterinarian and ran a butchery in Cambridge West (Leamington) until 1905, when they left to live in Matamata. They retired in 1918 and moved back to Leamington. Ben died in 1926 and Sarah in 1937."

Sarah Kingdon was born 28 March 1856 in Advent, Cornwall (from birth certificate). Benjamin & Sarah had 11 children, one of whom (Reginald Kingdon) is listed above. My GGM Nada Inez Rebecca born 12 May 1893. Can provide the names and birth dates of the other 9 children.
