Martha HARRIS = Edward BRITTON m. late C18th, Bitton. These are the GP's of Isaac BRITTON who m. 1859 = Mary Ann BATEMAN (See BATEMAN Study)

Hester	witness proving defendant Edward STONE not guilty of riot 4.11.1738
Jacob Isaac	HARRIS = Mary POOL on 19.10.1725 at St. Philip & St. Jacob, Bristol by licence. He was a cordwainer of Bitton Parish. Mary died 4.12.1781 aged 84 and he died in August 1782 aged 82. A son Isaac died on 22.9.1795 aged 55. All buried at Hanham Baptist. Possible daughter Mary but (perhaps baptism at St. Mary)
James	agreement between him, Thomas HAYNES and William LUTON of Bitton, coalminers, to work pits in Breachyate (Bridgeyate) Common for 4 years on 29.1.1729/30
John	25.10.1740; John of Mangotsfield, waggoner was charged at the quarter sessions with "bringing Elizabeth JARRETT, a poor impotent person into the parish of St. Peter, where she is chargeable, and likely to remain so."
John	mentioned in John CENNICK's diary (the lay preacher) as selected as a steward for the Society on 13.9.1741
Jonathan	and Martha his wife, in Bitton, Settlement Certificate from Titherington 12.6.1727
Joseph	witness proving defendant Edward STONE not guilty of riot 4.11.1738
Martha	see Jonathan, above
Mary	= William ROGERS botp 12.10.1766 Bitton (Witness: Isaac ROGERS)
Richard	Engineer, born Bitton c1826, resident Shepton Mallet c1867 to death 1901 [liznlesp.truro@bushinternet.com]
Sarah	= James ROGERS botp 27.12.1781
Sarah	= James FRANKHAM 1788, Bitton.
Samuel	of Winterbourne, bondsman for marriage of Arthur PALMER of Mangotsfield, yeoman and Sarah JONES of Bitton at Filton on 7.4.1733
Samuel	1747, listed as a male inhabitant of Oldland Bitton side.
Thomas	1747, listed as a male inhabitant of Oldland Bitton side.
Mrs HARRIS	one of three houses at Hanham mentioned 9.1.1749 as broken into two weeks before Christmas
by Thomas	BAYLEY and Thomas SMITH, two colliers, on the evidence of another collier, John PEARCE.
Unknown HARRIS	mentioned as drinking companion in Edward STONE case in 1739 [Ref. Annals of Kingswood]
