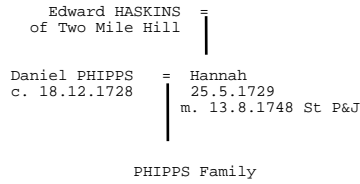

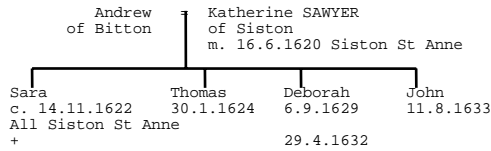

Aaron killed in coalpit, buried Siston 8.4.1774  
Abraham John POOL aged 20 arraigned for theft of 4 sash lights from Abraham HASKINS of Bitton; Glos Qtr Sessions; discharged by proclamation 21.8.1817 (GRO)  
This Abraham probably born 23.9.1781, Kingswood, Bitton:

George Henry WILLIS charged for stealing bay mare, property of George HASKINS, constable of Bitton; Bristol Gazette 14.8.1817

Hartley aged 18 alleged at Lawford's Gate Petty Sessions to be father of a child born to Emily GREEN, widow, 41, mother of 3 other children. Defendant was an apprentice of Mr PULLEN, wheelwright, Kingswood, father of Mrs GREEN. Case exciting much interest and its approaches were crowded. Case dismissed. Bristol Observer 20.2.1868. See Joseph below:
