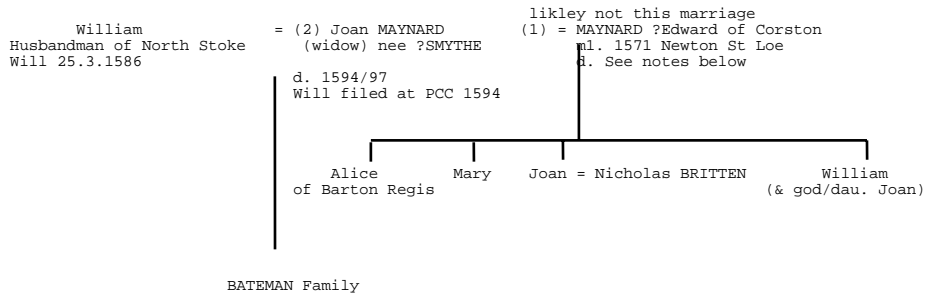


MAYNARD Family of North Stoke

MD1 Notes

Corston is parish adjoining North Stoke; many MAYNARD refs in PR down to mid C18th, all descended from Edward of Corston & Joan SMYTHE. Newton St Loe is also adjoining; PR contains numerous MAYNARDS from 1539 onwards. (in SOG)

Will of Edward MAYNARD, yeoman of Corston 1652 proved PCC;
if this is original Edward, then Joan SMYTHE not widow who married William BATMAN. Possible s/o of Edward, or death date to be confirmed. Edward = Joan Smythe had children at Corston 1573-83 & d. 1617.

The Maynard exchequer deponent 1588 was William.
Somerset Subsidy Rolls; 1597-98 Wm MAYNERD at North Stoke.
Glos will of Richard GUNNING of Cold Ashton, Bitton etc., d. 1559 of Bitton mentioned Wm MAYNERD of North Stoke as one of his debtors.

William MAYNARD who bought the copyhold of Stanton Prior Manor from Prior of Bath in 1533. Reportedly gave his age as 100 years in 1582, or his father. Probably also witnessed will of John HOLBYN of North Stoke 1548.

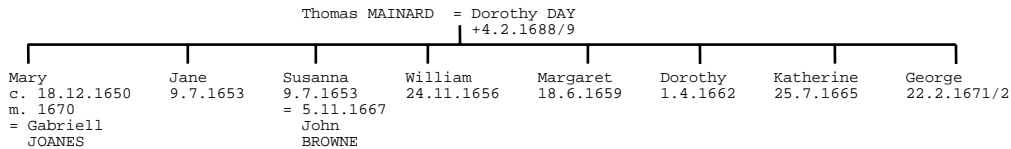

a. North Stoke Parish Register Transcripts 1655-1812:

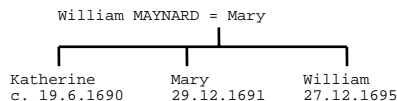
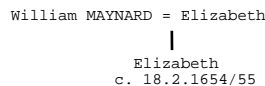
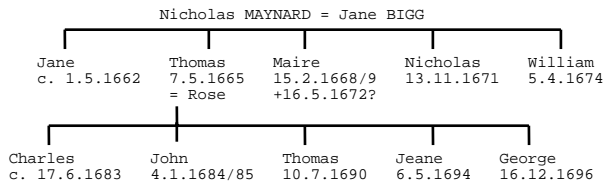
"Northstoke, 1649. The eighth day of October in the yeare of our Lord God one thousand six hundred fortie and nine, was a marriage had an solemnized between Thomas MAINARD of the parishe of Northstoke and Dorothy daughter of William DAY of the parish aforesaid."

"AD 1670 Gabriell JOANES of Bitton was married to Mary MAYNARD of this parish of Northstoke the eight day of June Ano predicto."

" 1677 On the fifth day of November was John BROWNE of the parishe of Weston and Susanna MAYNARD of the parishe of Northstoke, married." also "5/11/1677 John BROWNE of Siston - Susanna MAYNARD of Northstoke, by Hugh Davis (Married)"



"AD 1655 the 24th day of February 1655, the first time published an agreement of marriage to be had and solemnized between Nicholas MAYNARD and Jane BIGG daughter of Jane (sic) BIGG, both of the parish of Northstoke in the County aforesaid. The 3rd day of March 1655 the second time. The 10th day of March 1655 published the same the 3rd and last time. By me, Edward Bartlett, Register.
The parties above mentioned were (according to the Act of Parliament) married the 7th day of April 1656 by John Harington Esq., one of the Justices of Peace for the County...in presence of Robert Latimer, Thomas MAYNARD."
