

### **1851 Census. The Monk/Monks etc of the SW.**

Transcribed from the Ancestry.com online copy of the 1851 Census by Dick Monks in November 2005.

The census was taken on 30 March 1851.

The order in which information appears for each individual is

Family name; Given name; relationship to the head of the household; marital condition; age; occupation; and place of birth.

Every attempt was made to include all versions of the name, and to include every individual either born or living in Wales, Gloucestershire, Bristol, Somersetshire, Cornwall, Wiltshire and Devon.

All data was transcribed, except for:

In some cases address information was not associated with the household, because it was on a previous census sheet, and time-consuming to find. If the address does not appear below it may well be found by searching on the database and scrolling back through the enumerators sheets until the address is found.

In most cases the "Ecclesiastical District" information was not transcribed with the Parish information as it was assumed that this was redundant.

I hope at least that you will get some amusement from this Aussie's desperate attempts to decipher local place names – why cannot English place names be simple as Oodnadatta and Toowoomba? Hopefully the names as transcribed are sufficiently close.

Ancestry.com allows searches to be made using 'exact' or 'soundex' retrieval of surnames, as is noted in the data below. Soundex searches produce similar sounding or similarly spelled names, and are essential for finding records which have errors of transcription in the surname, which are not uncommon in the search keys transcribed by Ancestry.com. Transcription errors in the Ancestry.com database only degrade the searching for the data, not the data itself, which are photocopies of the original enumerators forms.

However, soundex searches often yield too many spurious results to safely dig out the wanted ones, so initially I used them solely to identify all the possible variations of our names. However, as I learned my way around, I changed my approach and this has changed the way in which later results have been grouped. Hopefully I got em all – I do know that I got some twice! (Looking through the data, I think I may have missed the Monks (exact) individuals who were born in Wiltshire and in 1851 not living in one of the other target counties.)

On a few occasions I felt certain that the Ancestry.com transcription was wrong and in these cases (but never in the case of placename information) I used my interpretation of the original data and made an appropriate note in the RH margin.

While there are numerous obvious typos in my transcription, I was careful to go back and correct any that might mislead.
