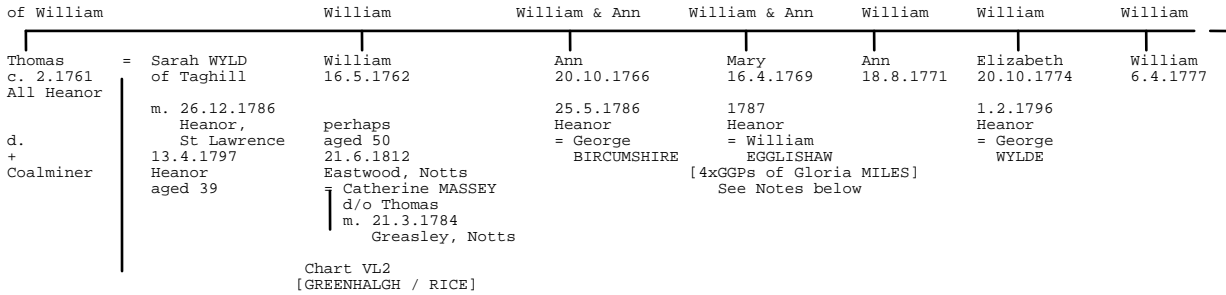
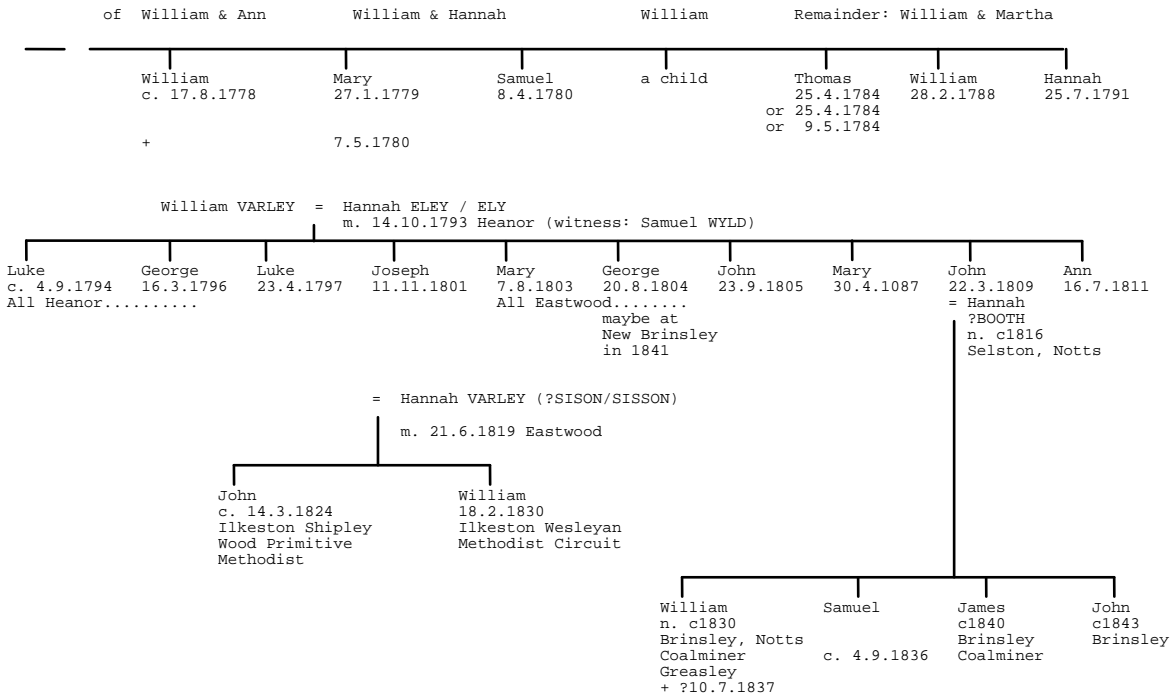

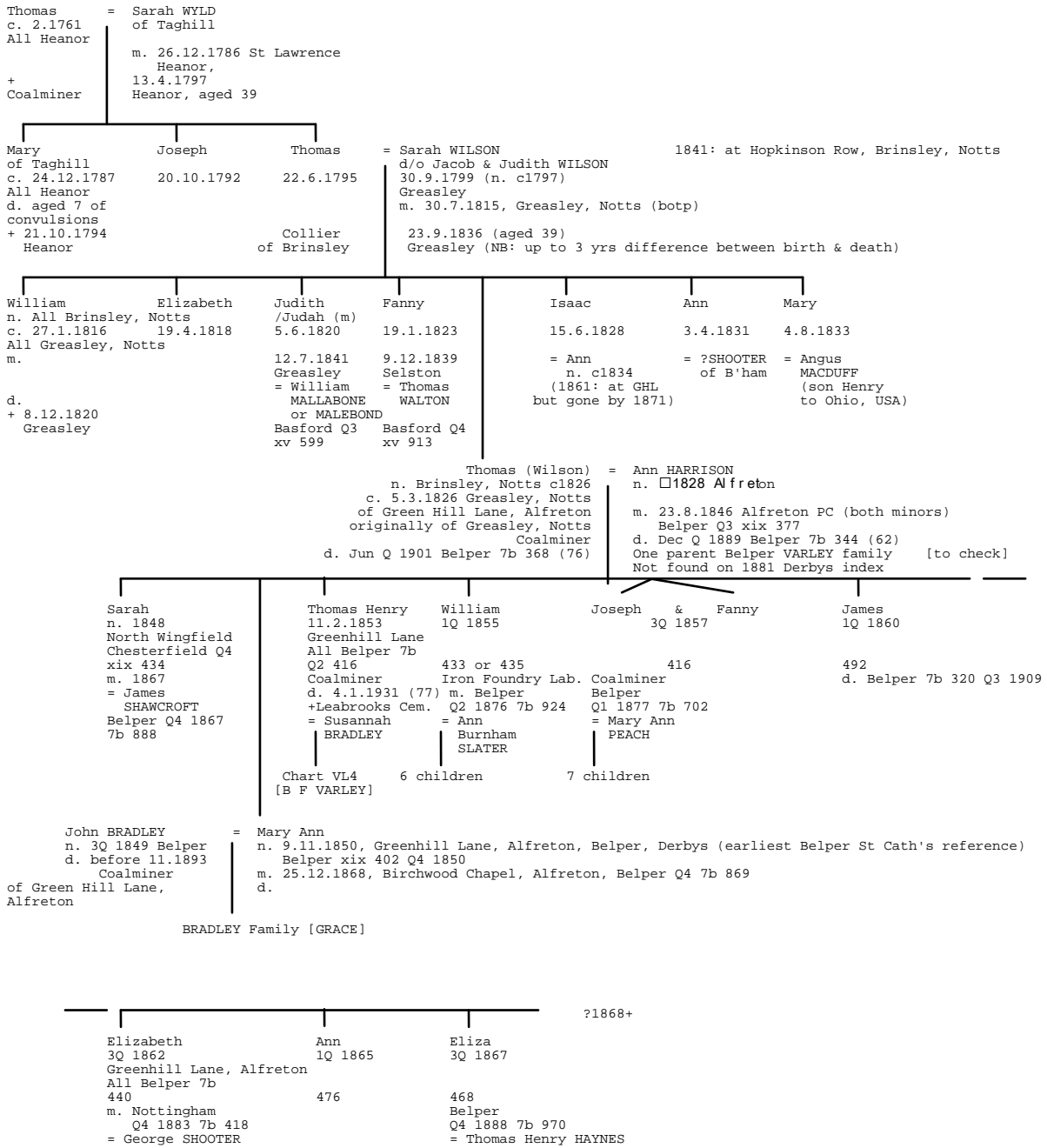

Ann GREEN (n. 1823) is Ann VARLEY on 1871 census (m. not found). Charlotte GREEN = Joseph VARLEY at Selston on 6.10.1846 (They went to USA some time around 1860 and on 1880 USA census they are living at Braidwood, Will, Illinois. Matilda GREEN (n. 1833 Selston) = William VARLEY at Selston on 4.4.1852.

Local History Notes

In Belper Registration district there are also families named VARNEY and VARDY, but do not appear to be connected to this only Belper family. VARLEY very common in S. Yorks area. Family with roots outside Belper district, but likely in Alfreton for 1851 and 1861 census, possibly also 1871.

Greenhill Lane (GHL):

not a street in Alfreton, but one apparently running between the villages of Swanwick (some GHL refs in 1841) and Riddings. The majority of references suggest that GHL is a district hamlet and is treated as a village in the 1851 census. The latter is supported by local maps showing the village to be clearly separate. The common cemetery is at Leabrooks. Greasley is the parish church for Brinsley.

Other Census Notes

No VARLEY in 1841 in Greenhill Lane, but family of Charles VARDY and Ann (both 25, he Coalminer) Children Luke 6, Hannah 4, Eli 3, Francis 7 months, and lodger James HOW, 25 coalminer.

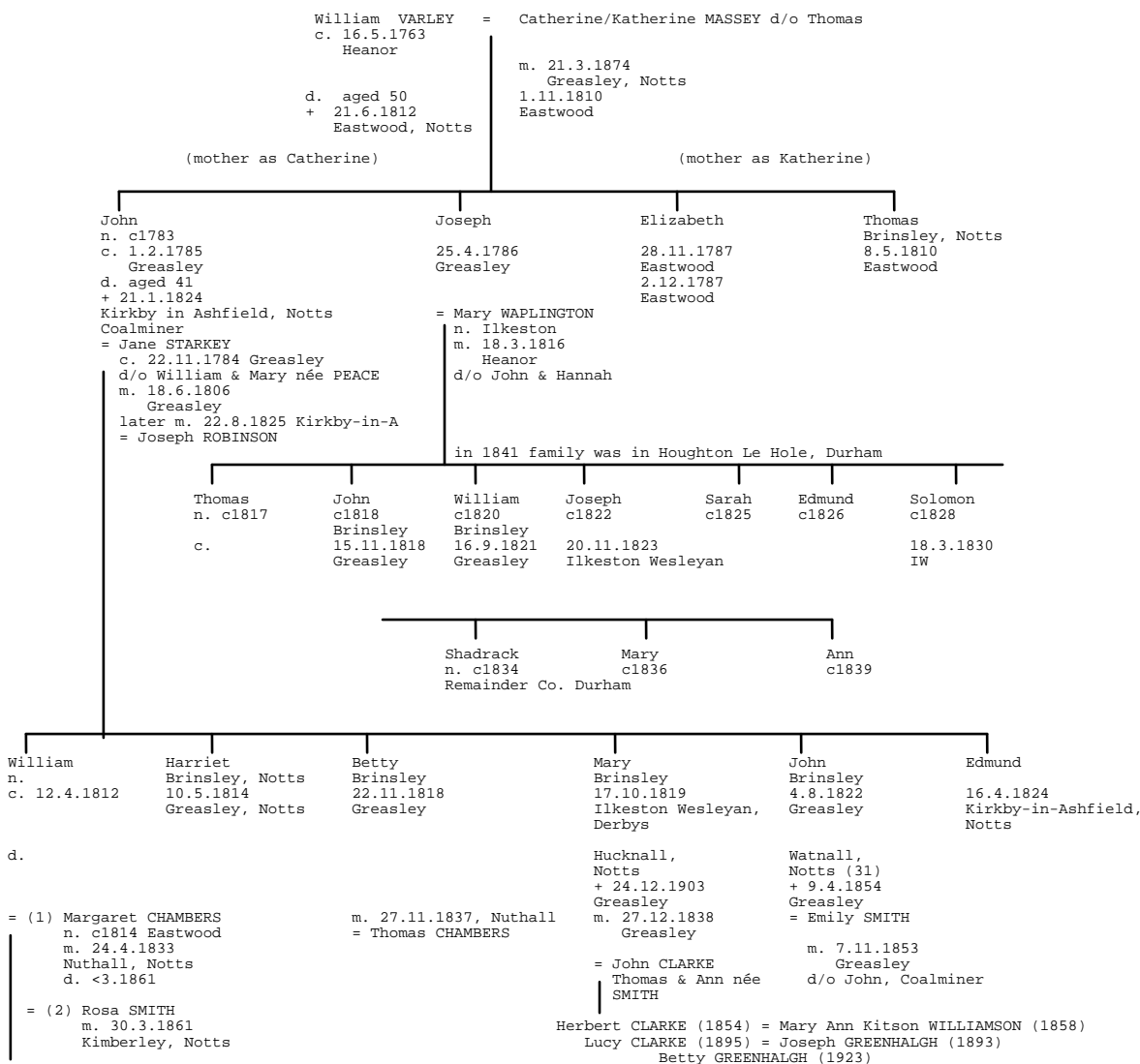
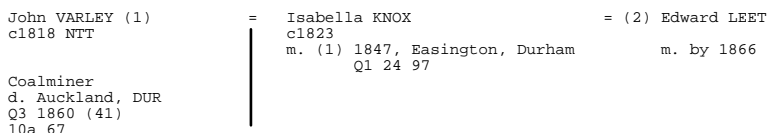

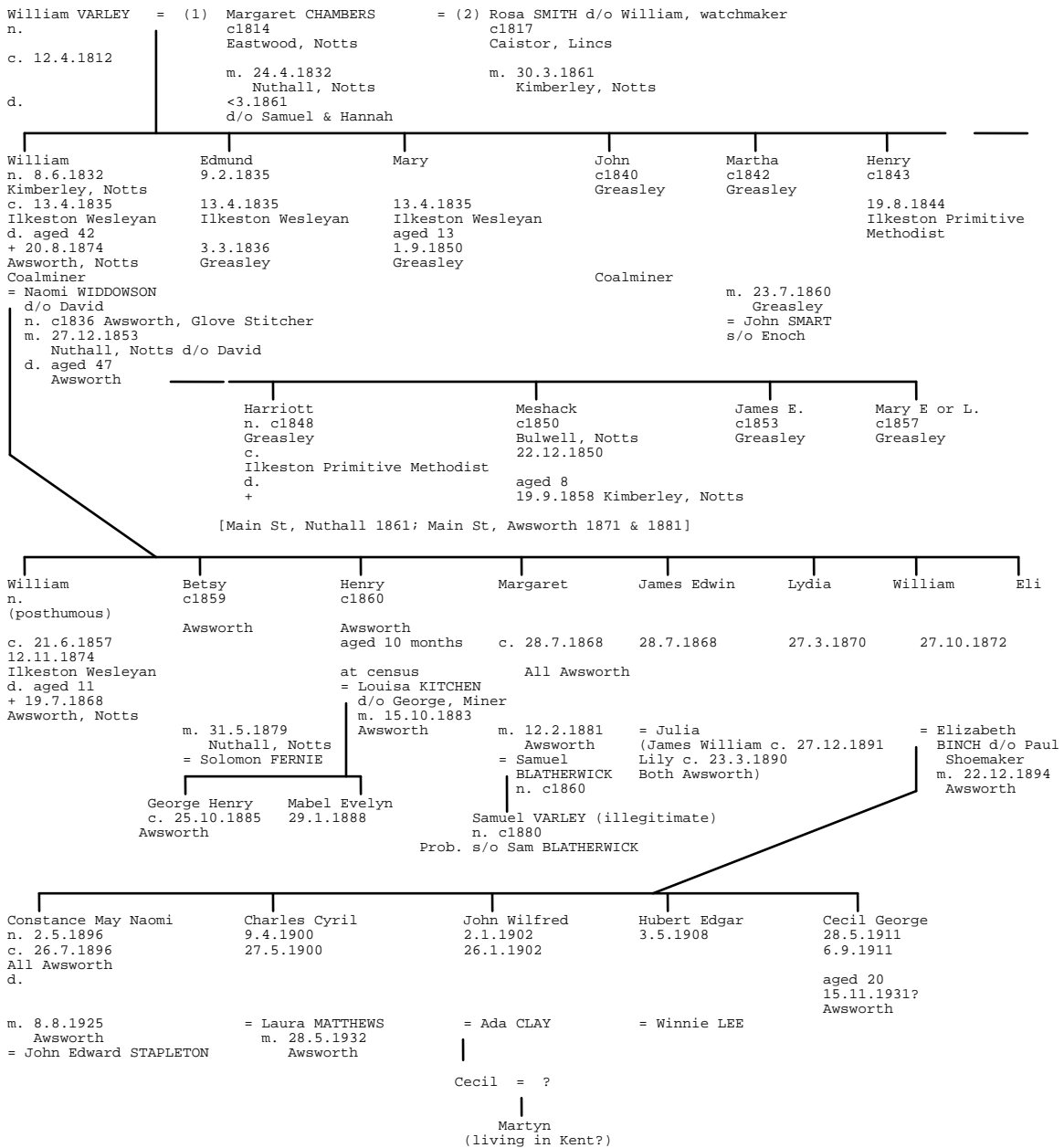

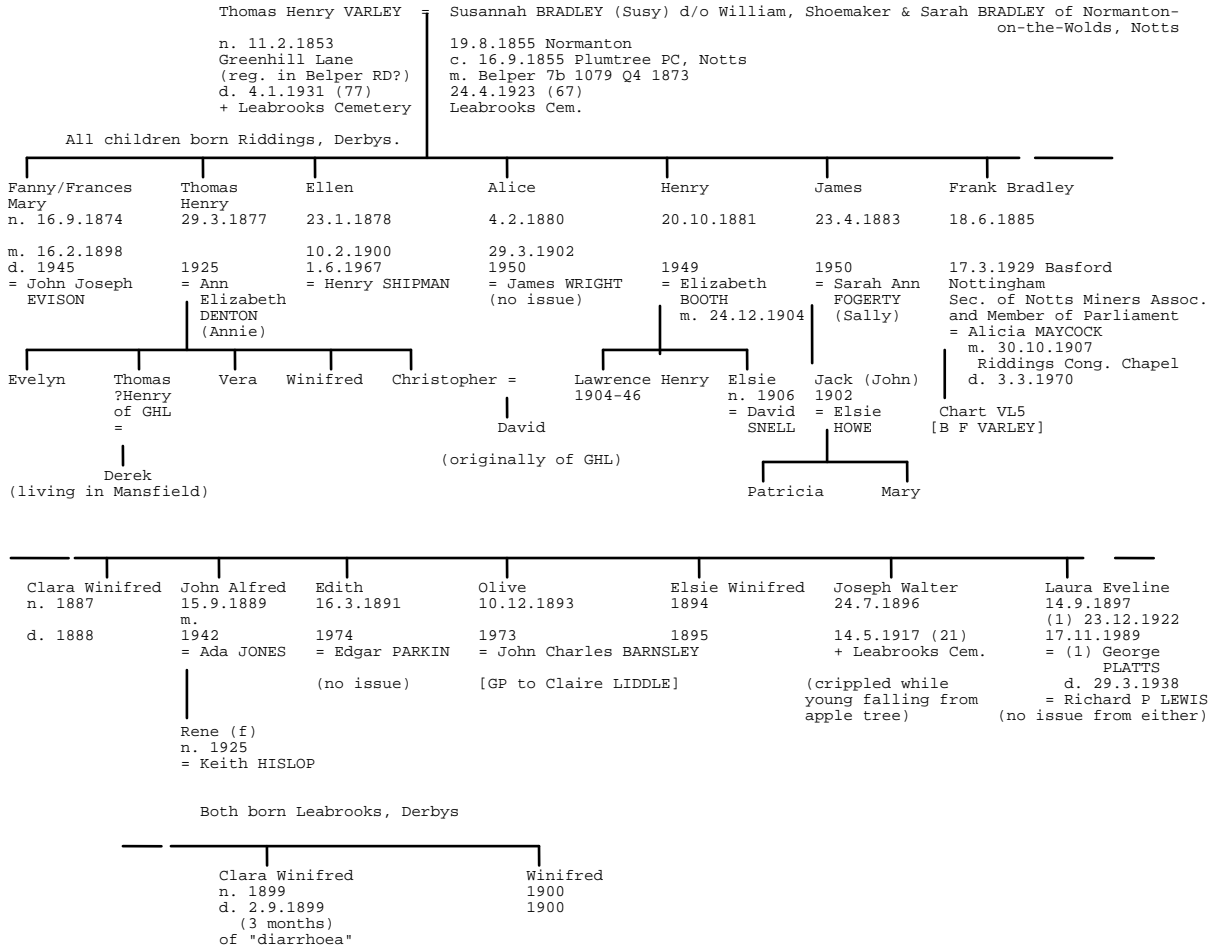

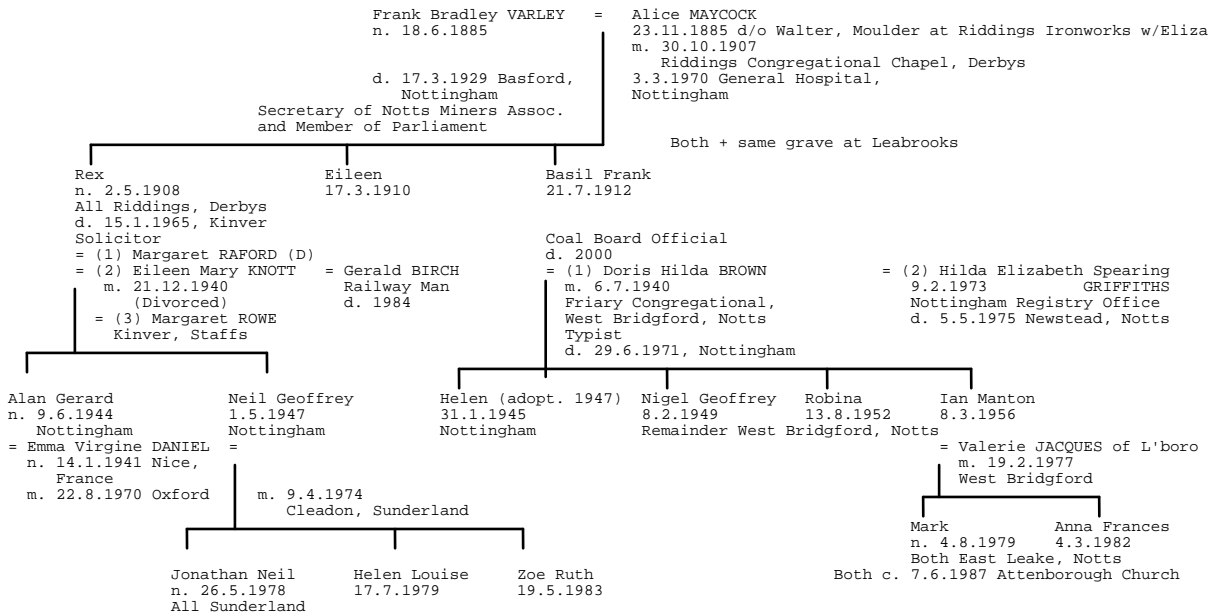

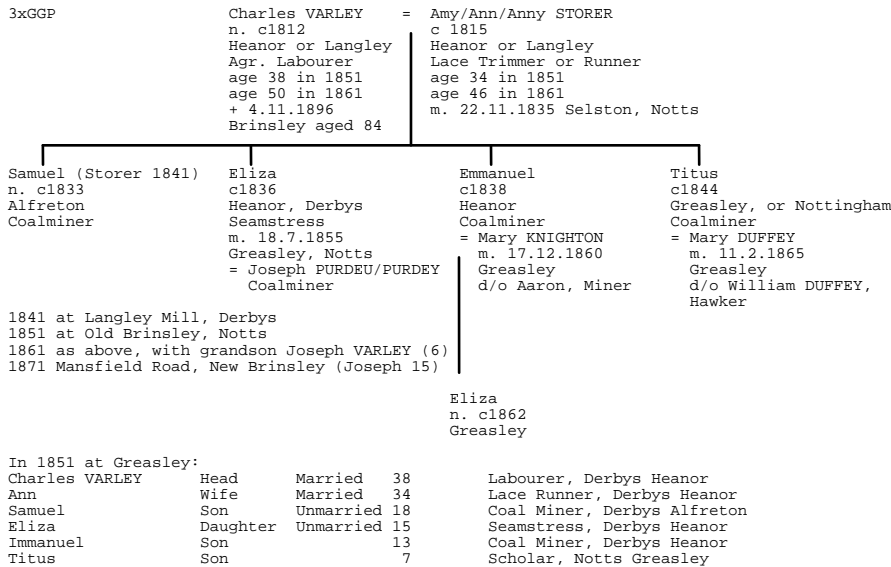
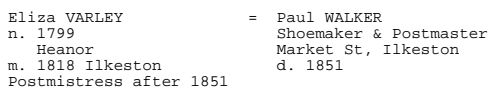


CHART VL7: Ancestry of Eliza VARLEY of Heanor [DESAI]

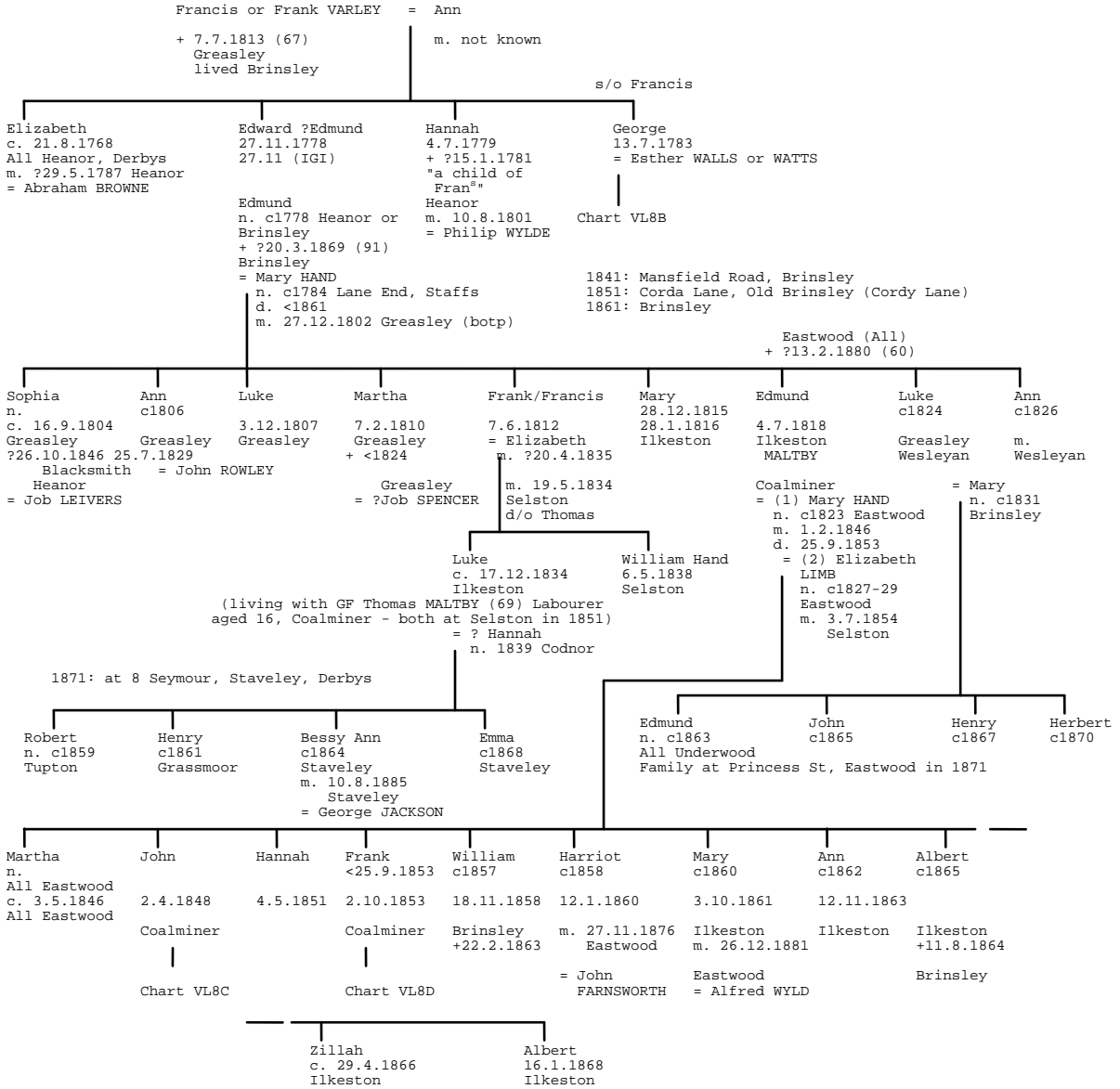

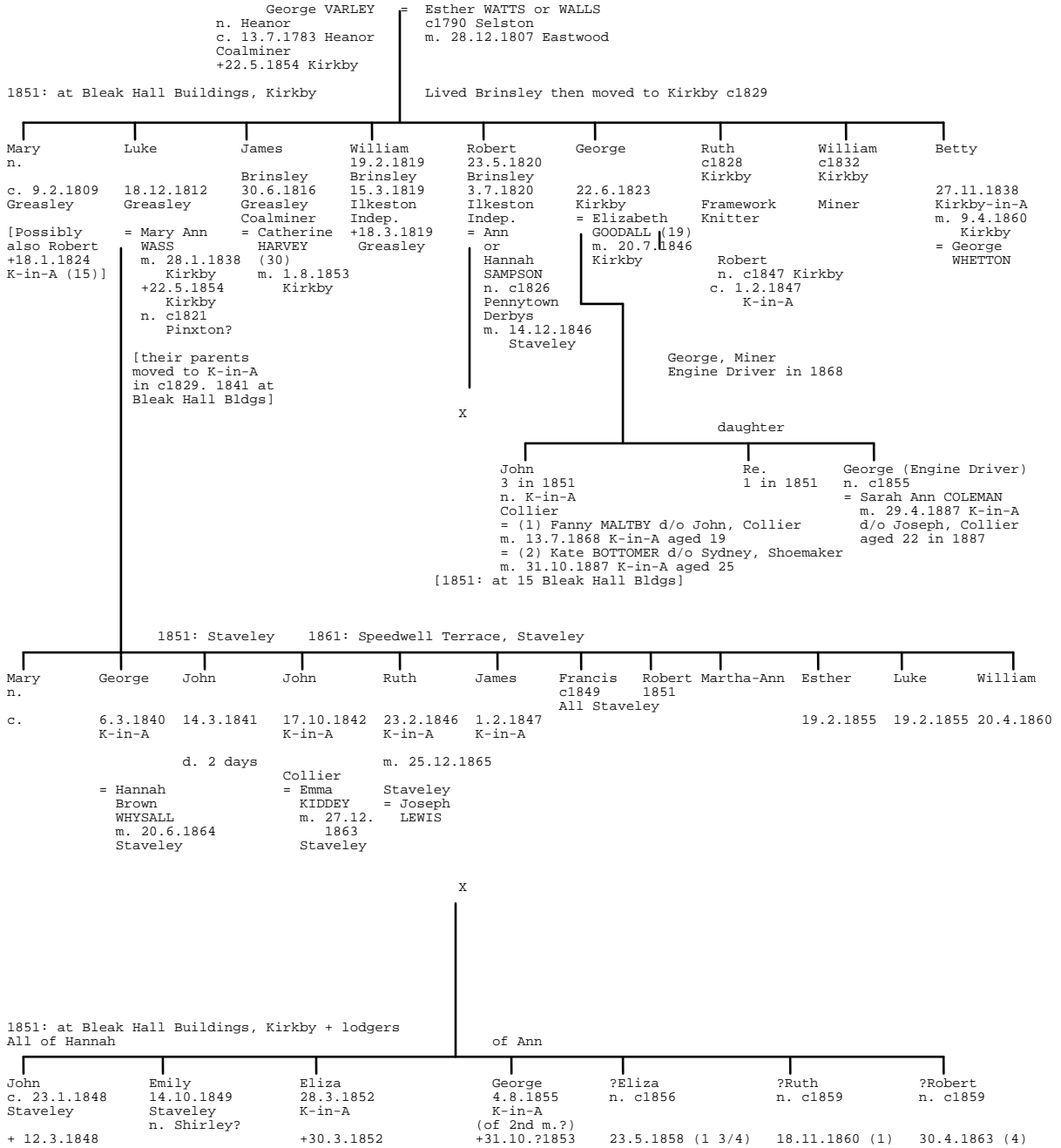

CHART VL8B: Descendants of George VARLEY & Esther WALLS or WATTS

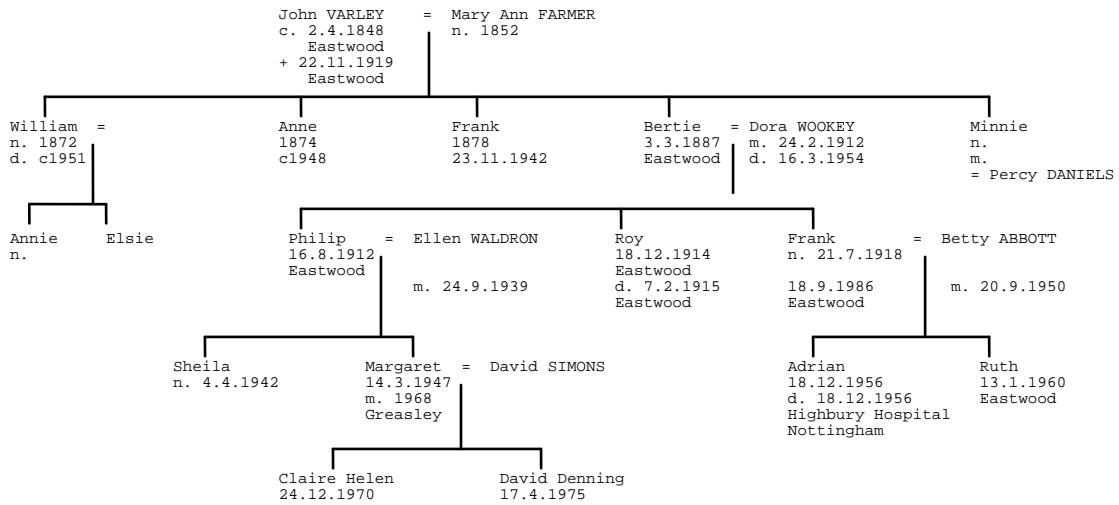

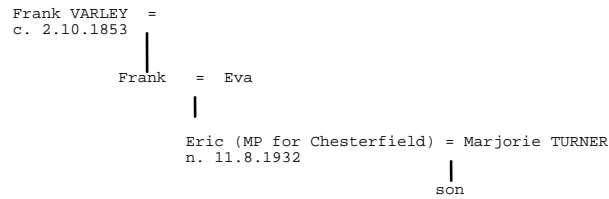

CHART VL8D: Descendants of Frank VARLEY

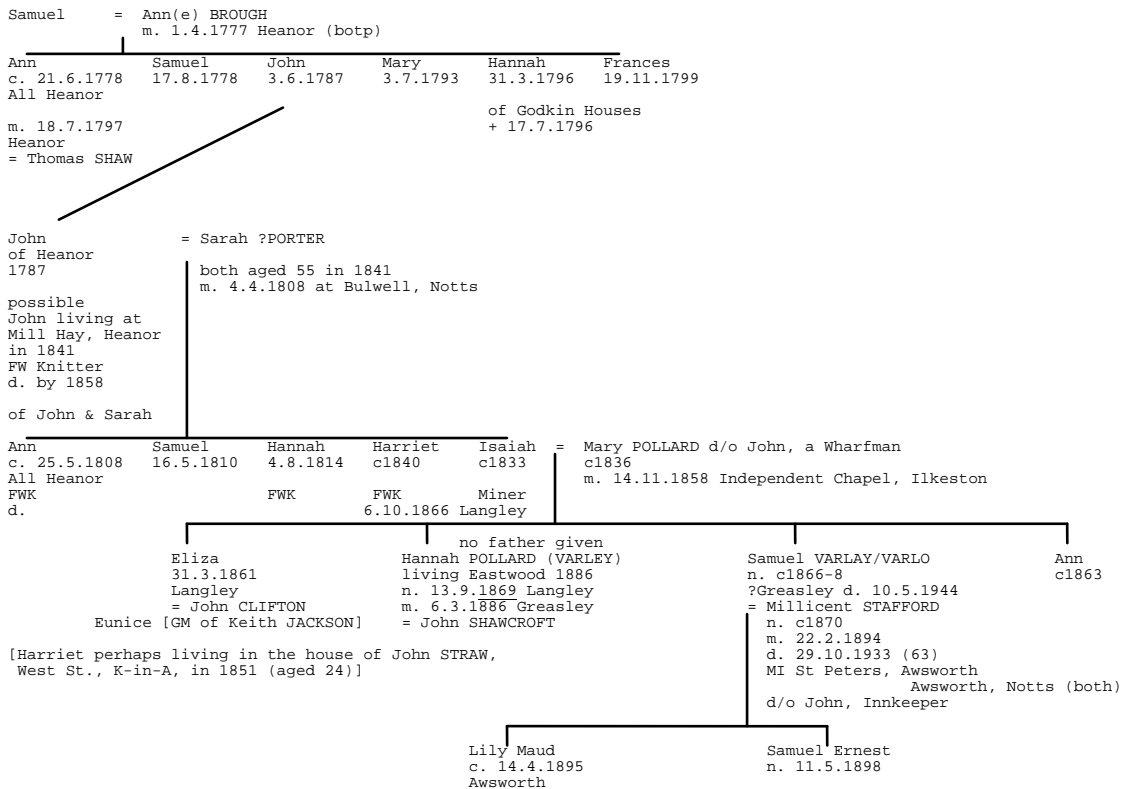

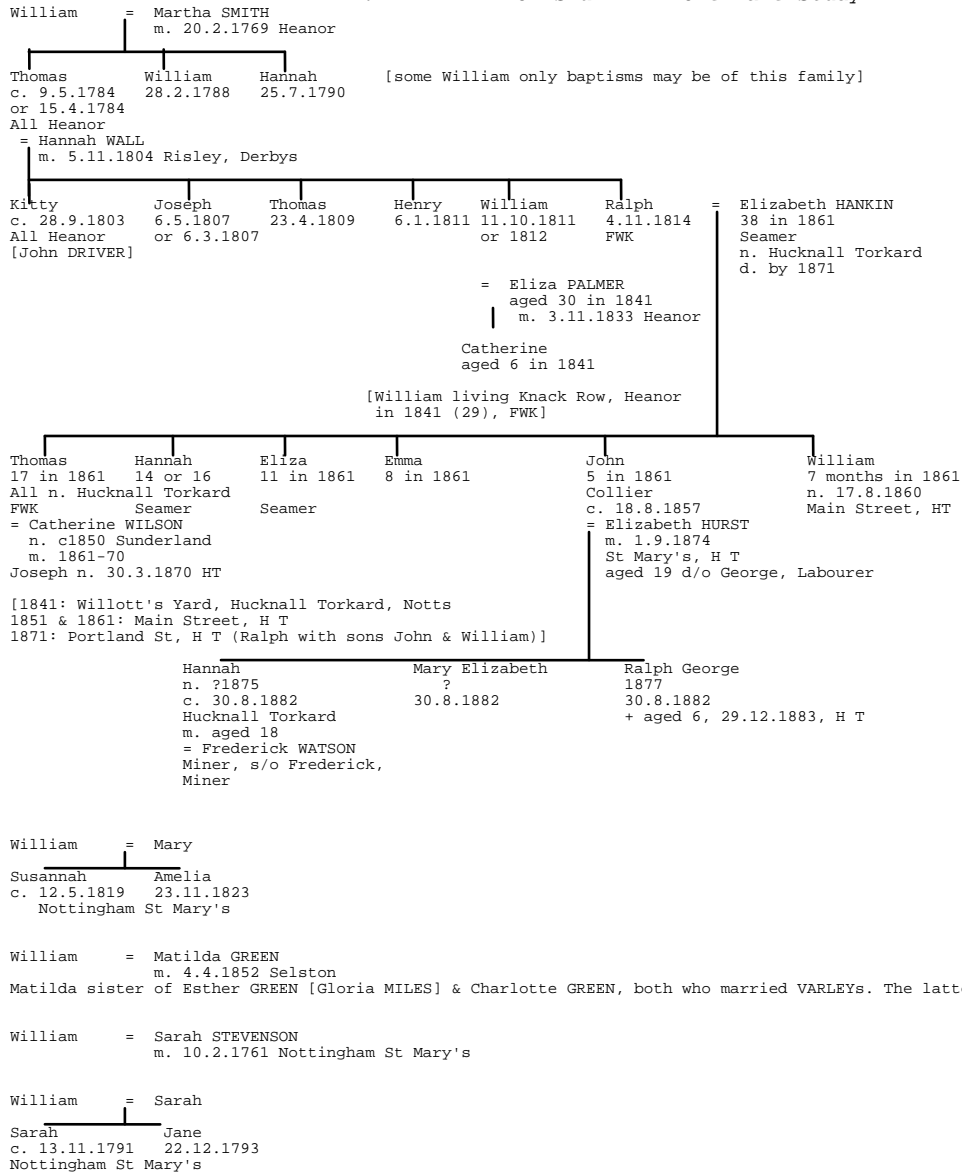

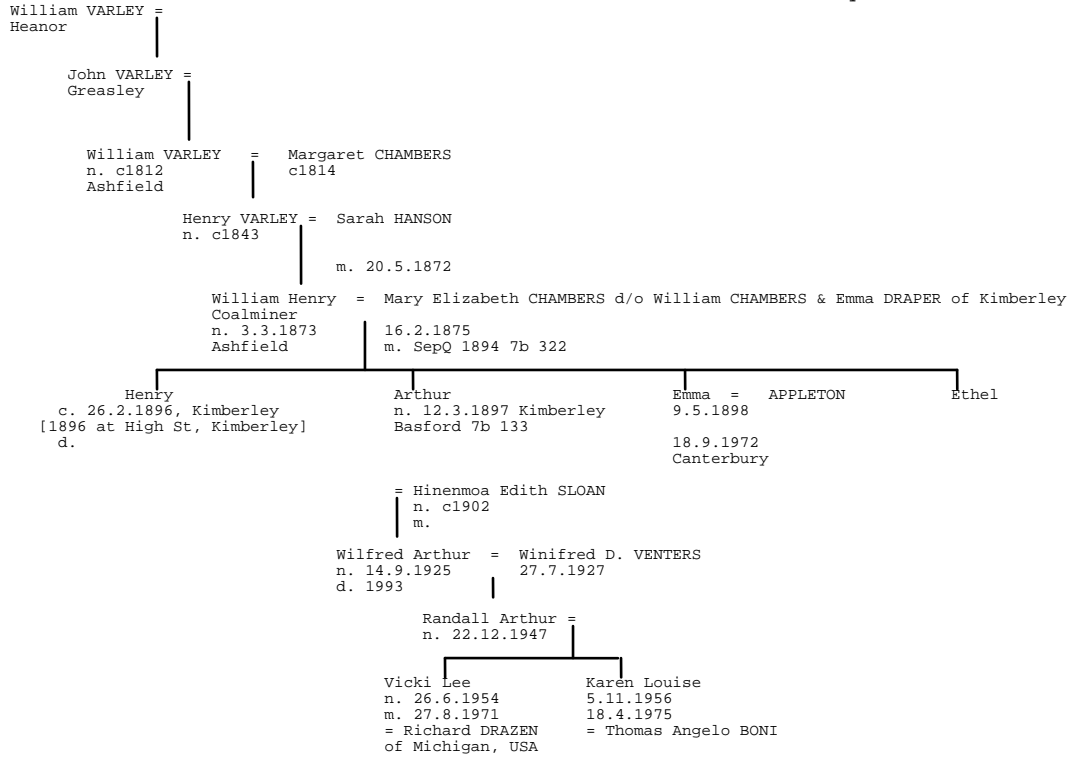
